International Student Estimated Expenses

In order to receive an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility for international admission to McHenry County College, U.S. federal immigration regulations require that international applicants provide proof of adequate financial resources to live and study in the U.S. for at least one full academic year. The tuition rate for all F-1 international students at McHenry County College will be assessed at the foreign tuition rate, which is currently \$464.38 per credit hour.

When calculating expenses, please keep in mind that students holding F-1 non-immigrant status are allowed to work a maximum of 20 hours per week on campus during fall/spring semesters. Off campus employment may be authorized after one academic year with governmental approval, if the student is maintaining lawful F-1 status and is in good academic standing. Any off campus employment must be directly related to the student's field of study, indicated on the student's I-20. The student should not view employment as a significant source of financial support while attending McHenry County College.
