- Guaranteed general university admission at the time of transfer under following conditions:
 - o Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree from MCC
 - Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA for all coursework as computed by UWW; calculation includes coursework from all institutions, including developmental; repeat policy allows a course in which a grade of C- or below was originally earned may be repeated once, repeated grade will replace original when calculating GPA.
 - Requirements of the agreement must be completed within five academic years from the time of enrollment in an associate degree at MCC.
- AA or AS degree will be considered to have fulfilled UWW's general education requirements, with the exception of US Racial/Ethnic Diversity requirement.
- UWW will accept a maximum of 72 credits from a community college.
- Academic advising from both MCC academic advisors and UWW transfer support staff
- Clear path to select degree programs
