Such changes take precedence over the information on this guide. Students should work with an MCC advisor and the four-year transfer school. Responsibility for complying with all applicable requirements ultimately rests with the student.

Admission Information

- **Application and admission** - Students are strongly advised to study the ISU catalog and to consult with a counselor for specific admission and course requirements within the College of Nursing.
- **Application deadline** - Admission decisions are communicated on a rolling basis. Here are upcoming deadlines:
 - **Fall 2019:** August 1, 2020
 - **Spring 2020:** December 17, 2019
 - **Fall 2020:** August 1, 2020
- Complete an ISU admission application which includes a Mennonite College of Nursing admission application with reference form.
- Highest admission consideration is granted to transfer students with the strongest academic preparation. Cumulative GPA and progress toward completion of general education and major program degree requirements are the most important factors in admission decisions.
- **Admission GPA calculation** - For repeat courses, ISU uses the most recent repeated grade for calculating admission GPA.
- **Admission requirements**
 - Graduate from state-approved diploma school of nursing or an associate degree nursing program
 - Licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Illinois (at time of admission – students completing ADN in May must receive notification of passing Nursing Licensure Exam in order to start RN to BSN sequence in fall)
 - Submit one recommendation form from a current employer, or if not employed, from a recent college instructor or academic advisor
 - Submit a resume to include: education, certifications, professional/community members of committee involvement, mentoring, award, description of non-student based work experience, and scope of responsibility associated with employment positions.
 - Submit 2 page maximum double spaced essay as follows: Describe your rationale for pursuing an advanced degree at this time and the circumstances that may affect an admission decision.
 - Minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA
 - Completion of Mennonite College of Nursing prerequisite courses with a C or better prior to the start of the fall semester (not at time of application): PSY151, PSY250, BIO255, BIO263, BIO264, HFE250 and a portion of IAI GECC (Communication) prior to the start of the fall semester; remainder of IAI GECC must be completed prior to graduation.
 - Completion of ISU global studies requirement recommended prior to admission. One of the following courses will satisfy ISU's requirement and an IAI Humanities or Fine Arts or Social & Behavioral requirement: ART155, 165; ANT151, 170; ENG272, 276; GEG203, 204; HIS165; MUS153; PHI160, 261; PLT251, 261, 281.

- **Grade Requirement** - With the exception of ENG151 and 152, ISU will accept the D grade for general education requirements. All prerequisite and major related courses require a minimum C grade.

Additional Information

- Associate Degree nursing courses are “held in escrow” until successful completion of three ISU Nursing courses: NUR223, 227, and 236. Once completed with a C or greater, 34 credits are placed on the student’s transcript for the following Nursing courses: NUR 229, 231, 314, 316, 317, and 325.
- The following options satisfy ISU’s general education requirements for transfer students:
 - Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum (GECC Credential), including a global studies (AMALI) course
 - An MCC AA degree or a bachelor’s degree from a regional accredited institution, including a global studies course (AS degree under 2015/16 or prior catalog)
- **Tuition 2019/20** – 384.13 per credit hour; fees not included

Education Plan

This plan includes coursework that satisfies MCC’s Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) and the IAI General Education Core, along with ISU’s RN to BSN general education and nursing prerequisite requirements. Courses in **bold** print are ISU nursing prerequisites and must be completed with a grade of C or better.
