Such changes take precedence over the information on this guide. Students should work with an MCC advisor and the four-year transfer school. Responsibility for complying with all applicable requirements ultimately rests with the student.

Indiana Wesleyan University (IWU) is a private, not-for-profit, Christian, liberal arts university. IWU's nursing program is accredited by the Indiana Board of Nursing Registration and the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.

**Admission**

- Proof of current unencumbered RN licensure (Students can be accepted provisionally while they are waiting to take their NCLEX)
- Official transcripts from all previous college or university studies at regionally accredited colleges or universities
- An associate degree with a major in Nursing with at least 60 transferable credits from a regionally accredited college or university
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 from all previous college studies from all previous college studies. If the applicant's GPA is below 2.0, the student may be admitted on a probationary basis, as established by the guidelines of the School of Nursing.

**Transferring Credit**

- Credits from a regionally-accredited institution
- College-level 100 or above (Not pre-college, remedial, developmental, credits through testing or assessed learning)
- Grade of C or higher

**Additional Information**

- Degree program requires 120 credits to graduate with BSN.
- Minimum 31 credits completed through IWU (see education plan on page 2)
- New cohorts start seven times per year. Students pick the most convenient time of the year to enroll.
- Registration, delivery and degree format
  - Accelerated program, 15 months to complete BS/Fast-track option 10 months
  - Cohort model, class size usually 12-18 students
  - Courses taken sequentially, one at a time, with vacation weeks around major holidays.
  - Register for all courses in program at one time with no obligation to pay for more courses than you take. Once coursework begins, IWU freezes tuition, textbook costs, and all fees for the duration of coursework.
  - Should an unforeseen emergency arise, students can work with an academic advisor to adjust schedule.
  - Textbooks and course materials delivered directly to student; included in total program cost
  - Technical support – live assistance every day of the week
- Students must earn a C or greater in individual required courses.
- An overall cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 is required to earn the BSN degree.
