- Apply to Eastern and have official transcripts sent from high school and college
- Courses taken at a community college will not be used toward upper division requirements. 40 semester hours of upper division credit is required for a Bachelors Degree. These courses are to be taken at the senior level institution.
- Foreign Language is a graduation requirement. Two full years of high school foreign language with a "C" average or completion of the second semester of a college foreign language will satisfy this requirement.

ⁱ A "C" or better is required in English, Speech, Math (Algebra or higher) and all courses for the major.

ii Either the Physical Science or the Life Science class must have a lab component. A total of 7 hours in sciences is required.

iii A U.S. Government or Constitution course is required for teacher certification. PTS 151 is recommended.

^{iv} Transfer students with 29 or fewer hours must complete MUS 1103 (5) times; 30-59 transfer hours must complete MUS 1103 (4) times; 60 or more transfer hours must complete MUS 1103 (3) times.

^v Completion of the Advanced Study Jury is required in order to complete the Junior Recital.

vi If the Cultural Diversity Requirement has not yet been completed, choose a Social and Behavioral Sciences course that also fulfills this requirement.
