Baccalaureate Degree Requirements. Each candidate for a bachelor's degree must complete the requirements listed:

Hour Requirements. Each student must complete at least 120 semester hours of credit. Each student must have at least 39 hours in courses that number 300 or above from a four-year institution.

Residence Requirements. Each student must complete the residence requirement by taking 30 credits hours with Columbia College.

Grade Point Average Requirements. Each student must have a *Columbia College cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher at the time of degree completion. The GPA is computed using only Columbia College courses.*

A2B Program (Associate to Bachelor Program)

By participating in the A2B program, you will receive a **four-year degree plan** from Columbia College Missouri and your Columbia **catalog year will be locked in**. This means the degree plan you are using when you sign up to participate will be the same as when you transfer to Columbia. Guaranteed Admission. Admission is guaranteed to Columbia College to complete an approved bachelor's degree to qualifying students, provided admission requirements are met at the time of transfer.

Associate Degree Transfer Grant. Eligible McHenry County College graduates receive a tuition grant of 5% good for six (6) consecutive semesters following transfer from MCC to Columbia College. Check with your local Columbia College academic advisor to confirm eligibility.

Tuition. Budget for college with confidence knowing that tuition is one affordable rate, books included. No add-ons with Columbia College. No fees. No book costs. No surprises.

Class Format: Six 8-week sessions annually.

In-seat classes meet one evening per week for 8-weeks. Flexibility to mix or match in-seat and online classes.
