MCC and SIUC have entered into a Program Articulation Agreement between the AAS in Business Management and the BS in Health Care Management. The agreement takes full advantage of SIUC's Capstone Option, which reduces the SIUC University Core Curriculum from 41 semester hours to 30. The program is offered through SIUC's Lake County site at Great Lakes Naval Training Center or through online delivery.

The Health Care Management Program (HCM) prepares students for a career in health management or health policy. It is a career oriented degree program designed to build upon work experience and teach additional skills in the areas of management and supervision.

### **ADMISSION**

A McHenry County College graduate receiving an AAS in Business Management will be considered for the Capstone Option and admission to SIUC's Health Care Management program, if the following are met:

- Completion of SIUC undergraduate admissions application and admission to the University
- Minimum cumulative 2.30 GPA for collegiate work as calculated by SIUC
- Completion of at least 15 credit hours of transferable SIUC University Core Curriculum credit, as noted on the second page of this guide
- Completion of the major related courses specified on the second page of this guide

A McHenry County College student transferring to the Heath Care Management degree program at SIUC who has not completed the AAS in Business Management at MCC will have related coursework evaluated on a course-by-course basis, will not be eligible for the Capstone Option, and will be considered based upon enrollment criteria and space availability.

**Note:** SIUC's Dual Admission Program allows baccalaureate oriented freshman students at community colleges to benefit from pre-advisement through SIUC for a chosen major at SIUC. For more information: http://admissions.siu.edu/dap/.

### **ADDITIONAL Courses You Can COMPLETE THROUGH MCC**

It is very important to work with the SIUC contact noted on the first page of this guide when selecting additional coursework. Please Note: SIUC requires a minimum of 42 semester hours of 300/400 level coursework completed through a four-year institution. (The last 30 hours of the bachelor's degree must be completed through SIUC.) This means that a maximum of 78 credits from a community college <u>will apply</u> toward SIUC's bachelor's degree. Some of the coursework in your AAS degree transfers to SIUC as elective credit, but it is beyond the number of elective credits that will apply to the BS degree. You may complete the following additional courses at MCC, and they will apply toward SIUC general education requirements.

### **SIUC General Education Requirements**

- MAT150 and/or IAI Life Science and/or IAI Physical Science SIUC requires each of the 3 courses, one of which can be completed through the AAS degree. Take courses not completed through your AAS degree.
